## Minutes from the March 5, 2008 ACCC Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Monte Rans at Don Hattan Chevrolet. We welcomed guest Dr. Phil (Zivnuska) who has an '07 Z06. ## Minutes from the March 19, 2008 ACCC E-Board Meeting

The meeting was held at Don Hattan Chevrolet. All board members were present.

President – Monte Rans called the meeting to order but had nothing new to discuss at this point.

Vice President – Jack Crossman reported 65 paid members. Membership lists should be correct.

Treasurer – Randy King reported that the club account is still in two banks. He will consolidate the accounts this month into only Bank of America. He voiced concern about the shrinking bank balance. He asked if we should consider a fund raiser. Marsha asked if Jim Hattan had reimbursed their share of the awards. He had no knowledge that they had. Monte will check on that.

Secretary –No report.

Officer-at-Large - Lin Smith has paid the deposit to the Petroleum for the 2008 Awards Banquet. The date is scheduled for Friday, January 16, 2009. All other details are the same as this year.

NCCC Governor – Gary Jones reported he had updated the membership since the original renewal submission. He asked who we should contact concerning new membership decals. It was suggested to contact Daryl or Don Crigler to ask where the current decals had been printed. Kent will check on it.

Newsletter Editor - Kent Michael had no report

Old Business – Monte reported that the cruise to Ugly's in Oklahoma would take about 2 ½ hours on the interstate whereas other routes could take up to 4 hours. The Board felt the interstate would be best. Members are reminded to bring lots of change for the tolls.

The invitation to the River Festival parade limits car clubs to only 12 entries. The fee is \$100.00. Jim Hattan will not pay the fee this year. The board decided not to recommend the club pay the fee for so few members. It was decided to have interested members share the entry fee cost.

There was discussion of the original contract with Don Hattan. Monte will review that contract with Jim Hattan and get an updated contract. Kent pointed out that we also need membership cards.

We still need to set up a date for the new club photo but must wait until the weather breaks.

### New Business

Kent mentioned that we have some patches and t-shirt transfers that we could sell if anyone is interested. We will check on the cost of having them put on t-shirts.

Marsha relayed information from a phone call from Don Crigler. He offered use of space he had in a large vault at his home. Some discussion ensued but no decision was made.

The meeting was adjourned.
