### New Business

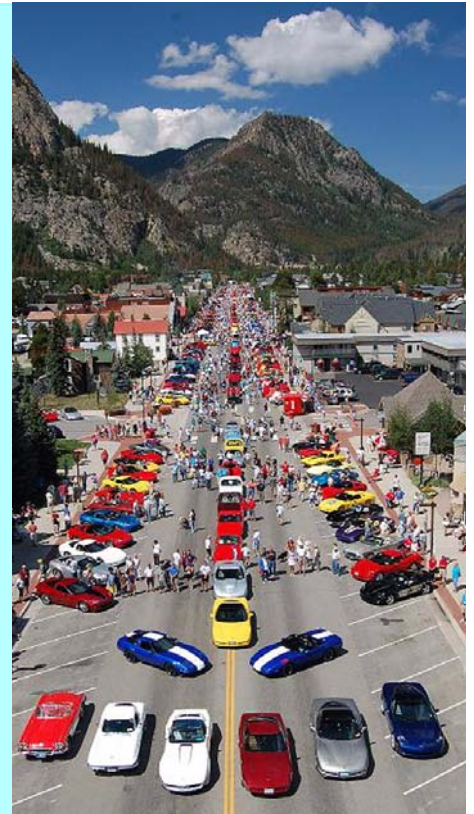
Marsha brought up the possibility of forming a social committee. After much discussion no action was taken.
