The meeting was called to order by President Monte Rans at Don Hattan Chevrolet. We had no guests. The minutes were approved as corrected. The correction was that the Funkhana was Sept. 7th not 20th. Treasurer - Randy King reported that the checking account has a current balance of \$1036.36 and the Savings account is \$1321.54 plus \$30.00 cash. He stated that the account will be changing because of the memberships being submitted.

Secretary - Marsha Battaglear had nothing.

Officer-at-Large - Lin Smith reported the points race has Monte Rans in 1st, Jack Crossman in 2nd, Kevin Mansfield 3rd, Lin Smith 4th, and David Snodgrass in 5th.

Governor - Gary Jones reported that he had paid the bill to the Western Region for \$32. He informed us of two car shows; one on Oct. 18th in Kingman, KS and one on Oct. 19th in St. Joseph, MO.

Old Business

Regular membership dues for A.C.C.C. are \$50.00 per year for new members and \$45.00 per year for renewals. Membership dues include A.C.C.C. spouse membership and one National Council of Corvette Clubs (N.C.C.C.) membership.

Associate membership, designed for the non-Corvette owner, is \$25.00 per year for new members and \$20.00 per year for renewals. Associate membership does not include spouse or N.C.C.C. membership.

A.C.C.C. requires all members to be at least 18 years of age and hold a current valid driver's license.

Dues for renewals are payable on September 1st and are considered delinquent after the November A.C.C.C. meeting. Renewals received after the November meeting will be considered as new. Memberships received after September 1st will be valid through the next calendar year.
