## Several Corvettes Up for Grabs

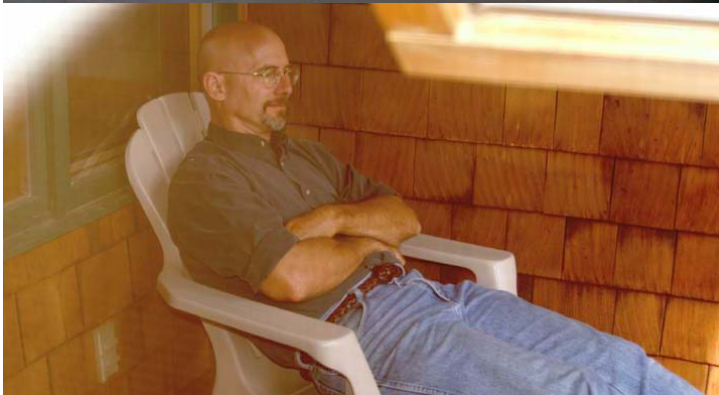
