### New Business

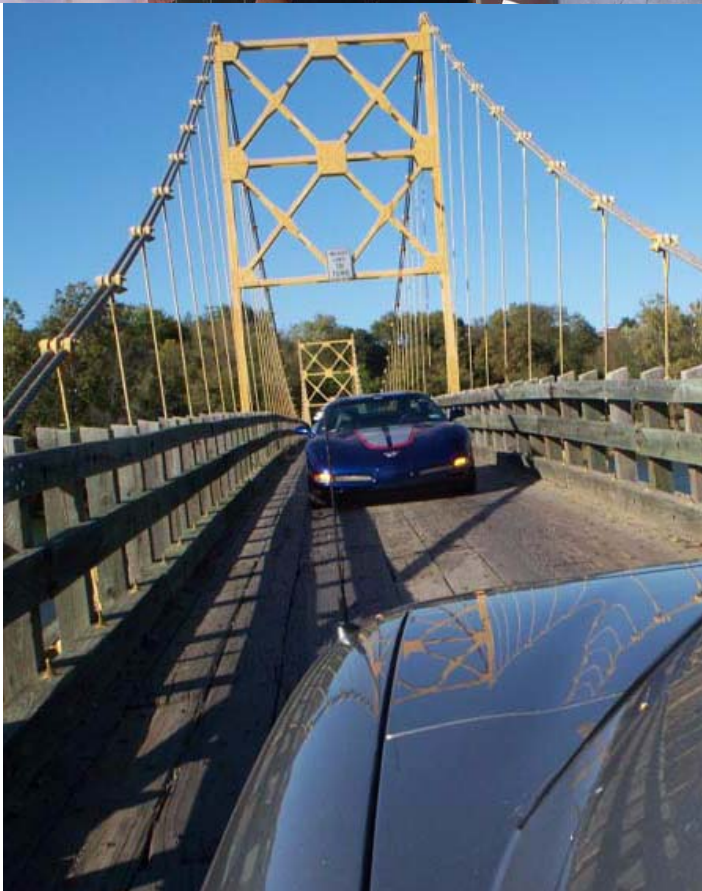
The sign-up sheet for Drive & Eat sponsors will be presented at the November meeting. Members are encouraged to sign-up to earn participation points.

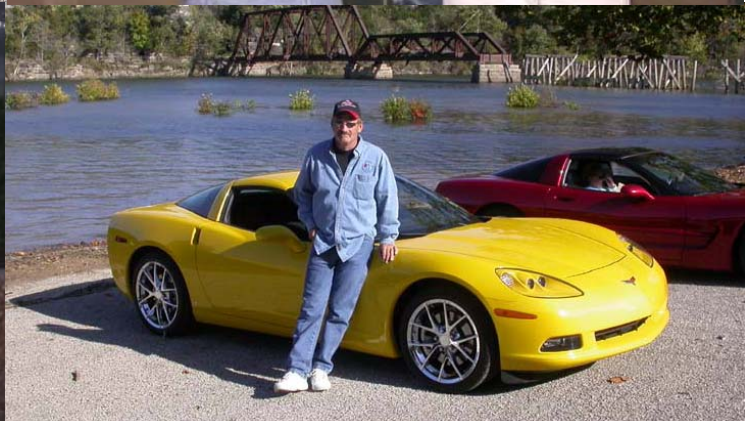
