Next E-board meeting will be at Dale & Barb's on Wednesday, July 21st at 7:00 p.m.

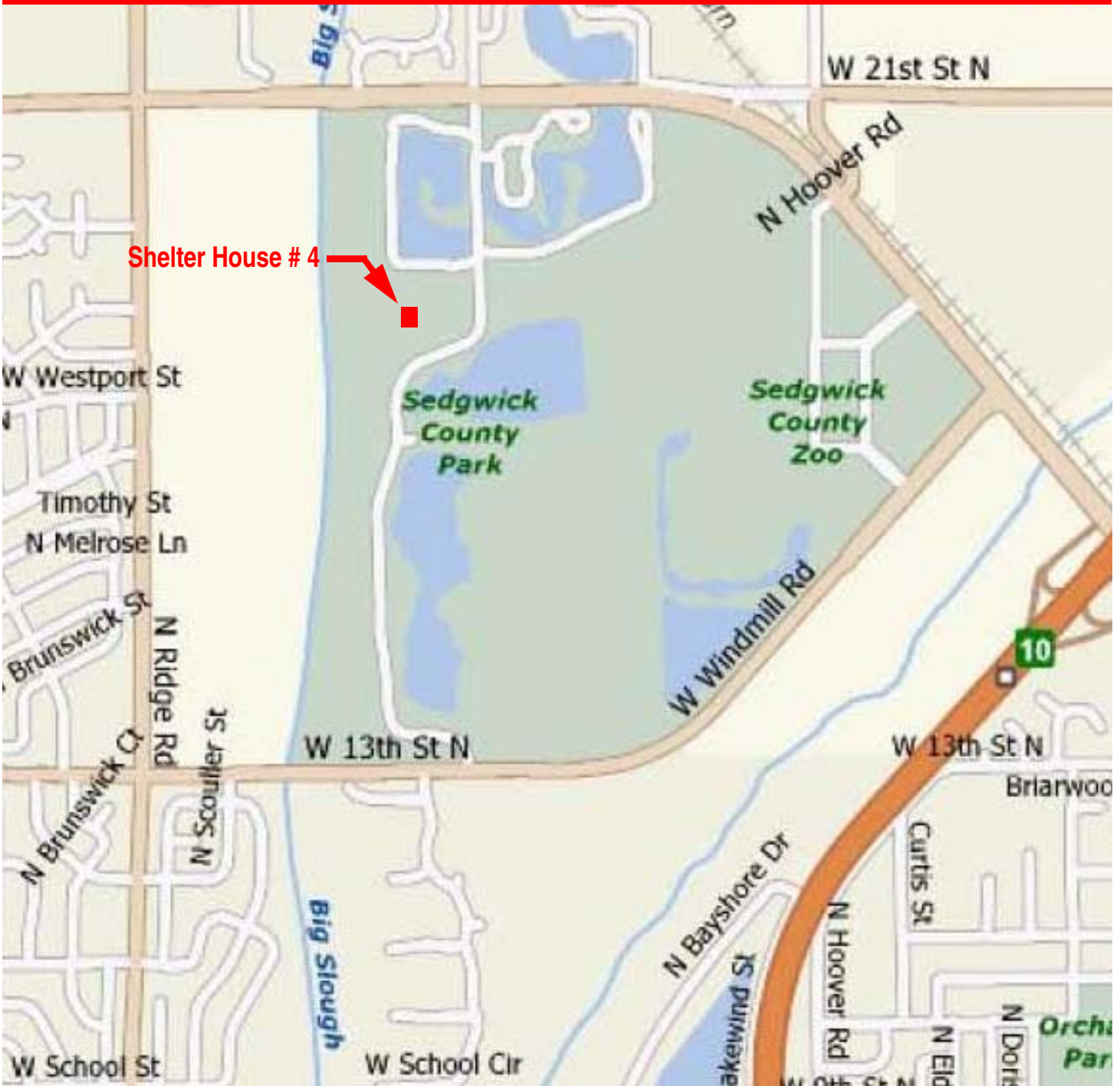
