New Business

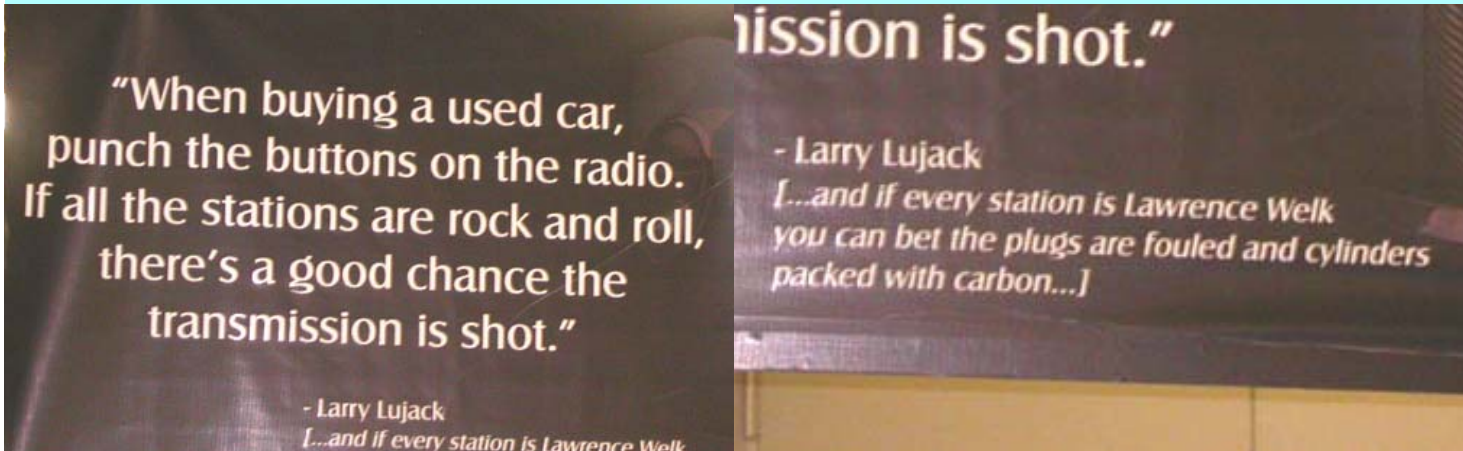

Minutes from the April 18, 2012 ACCC E-board Meeting

Meeting was called to order by President Glen Bailey.

There were no changes to the minutes of the April general meeting.

Secretary Daryl Burbach had nothing to report.

Vice President Barry Hooper reported that the club has 103 members.

Treasurer Art Warren reported a bank balance of \$3,374.05 with \$16.00 in cash. Art pointed out that Karri Keller had done an outstanding job as treasurer in his absence.

Officer at Large Mike McKee has a form showing the colors for club T-shirt orders. If not enough T-shirts are ordered, all monies will be refunded.

NCCC Governor Bob Battaglear and Gary Jones have been investigating the problem the club has with its tax exempt status. It appears that the form has not been filed for three years. It also appears that we, and most clubs in the state, were not notified so most clubs have also lost their tax exempt status. The governmental agency involved took no responsibility for the fact no forms were sent out. We will do whatever is necessary to be reinstated. We will develop a checklist of specific tasks each officer must perform, on a recurring basis. Purpose of the checklist:

- 1) Help prevent unintended oversights following hand-off from officer to a successor.
- 2) Help potential candidates decide if they want the responsibilities of the office.

Newsletter editor Kent Michael is investigating putting a password on parts of our web site making it available only to members.

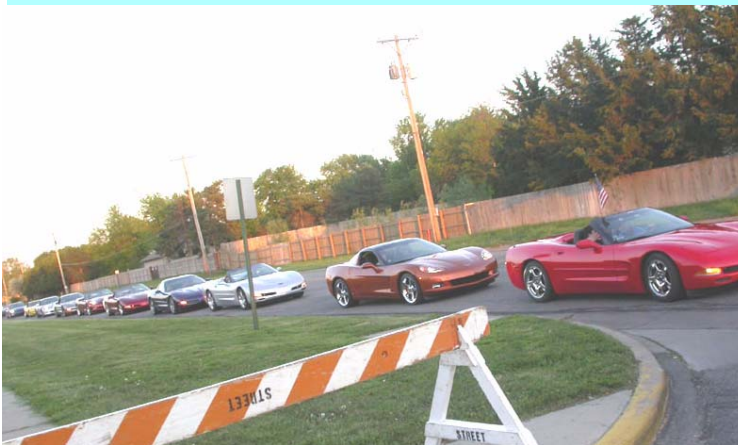
Old Business
