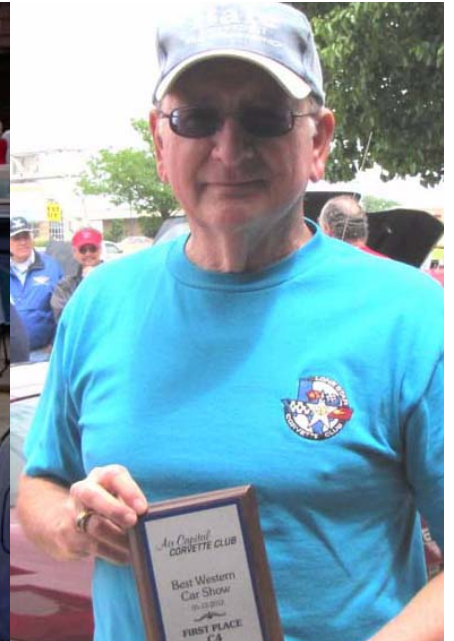

Minutes from the May 16, 2012 ACCC E-board Meeting

Meeting was called to order by President Glen Bailey.

Dick Preisser donated the proceeds of his model car sale at the Best Western Car Show to the club to be donated to a charity. The E-board voted to send the \$145 to the Orpheum Theatre. Thanks to Dick for the funds.

A \$50 donation was made to Catholic Charities in the name of Trisha Boswell. Trisha, Ron's wife, died after a long illness.

The club gave out 7 plaques at the Best Western Car Show. The cost was \$90.88.

There were no changes to the minutes of the April general meeting.

Secretary - Daryl Burbach had nothing to report.

Vice President - Barry Hoofer reported that the club has 107 members.

The National Corvette Museum is seeking clubs to pay for and display a banner outside at the NCM. This will be brought before the membership at the next meeting.

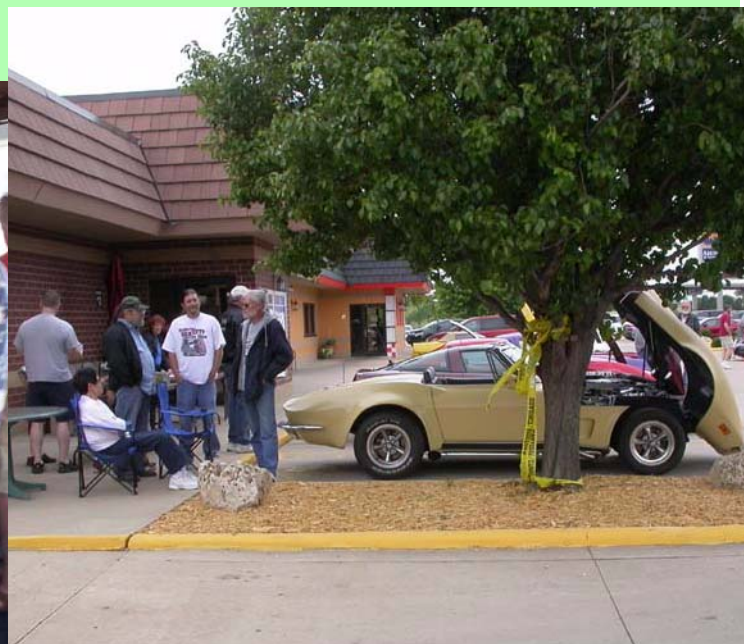
Glen is going to purchase a "Registration" banner for approximately \$35 to be used at car shows.


