We just sat back and watched the Airplanes fly by the Stearman Bar & Grill and ate a hot breakfast under a Big-Ass-Fan.

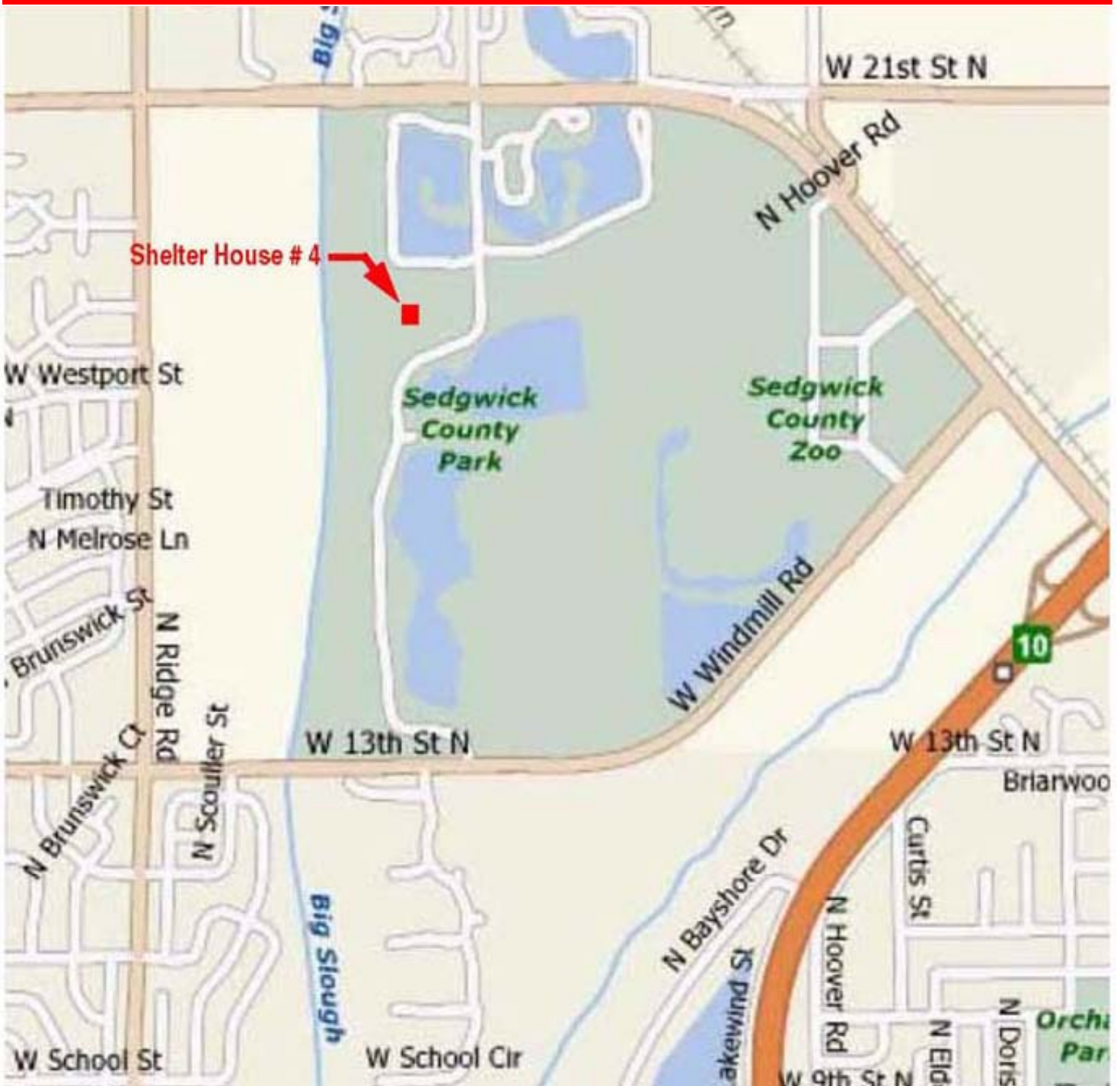

If you already have an NCCC membership elsewhere, **Regular Membership** dues for ACCC are \$25.00 per year for new members and \$20.00 per year for renewals. Please specify the following:

Associate membership, designed for the non-Corvette owner, is \$25.00 per year for new members and \$20.00 per year for renewals. Associate members are entitled to all the privileges of regular membership with the exception of voting and/or holding office. Associate membership does not include NCCC membership.

ACCC requires all members to be at least 18 years of age and hold a current valid driver's license.

Dues for renewals are payable on September 1st and are considered delinquent after the November ACCC meeting. Renewals received after the November meeting will be considered as new. Memberships received after September 1st will be valid through the next calendar year.
