Clutch Pedal Extension

For those of us built low to the ground for traction (i.e. short legs), the clutch pedal travel in the C5 and C6s leaves us using our tippy toes to push the clutch all the way to the floor. There is a fix, a clutch pedal extension. It is an ABS plastic unit that brings the clutch pedal closer to the driver by 1 1/4". It matches the clutch pedal in both design and color. It is pricey (\$50) but very well engineered and made. Now the clutch pedal feels very natural to me and I don't take it out of gear at stoplights just so I can release the clutch. It is called a clutch pedal extension and Mid America carries it and there are ads for it in the back pages of some Corvette magazines. Best addition I have made for my Vette and easily removable.
