your renewal forms and payments to the November meeting, so we don't have to call you.

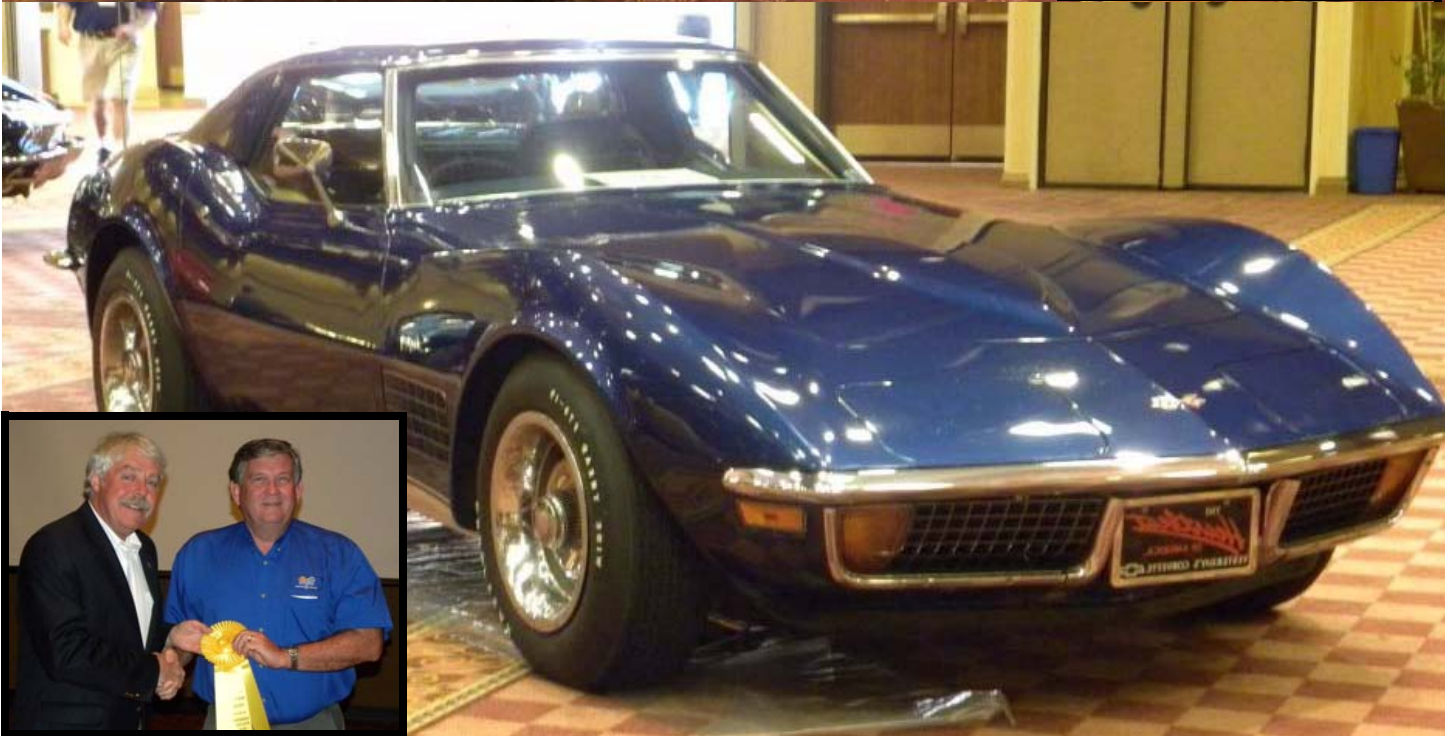
