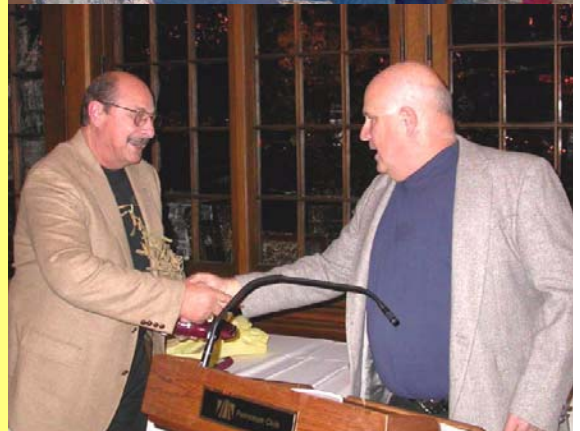
DEPUTY CITY TREASURER WINS FIRST TIME OUT

Sunday, April 13, turned out to be an excellent day for Deputy City Treasurer Gene Brown. It was on this day that Gene entered his first sports car race . . . and won! The race was the War Bonnet Regional, sponsored by the Neokla Region of the Sports Car Club of America and held at Keystone Lake, just outside of Tulsa, Oklahoma. Driving a green Sunbeam Alpine, Gene won the F production class race which featured a field of eight cars. This was not an easy victory for Gene as he held the lead and then lost it. Refusing to give up, Gene regained the lead and crossed the finish line one half lap ahead of the second place car, a Lotus 7A. The time for the 26 lap race was an even 25 minutes.

In preparation for the race, Gene had to attend two driver's schools, which required he spend six hours on a racetrack at the wheel of his Alpine. He wasted little time proving that it was a short time between school and the winners lane. With the racing season just under way, it looks like a busy year for Deputy City Treasurer Gene Brown.

Dues for renewals are payable on September 1st and are considered delinquent after the November ACCC meeting. Renewals received after the November meeting will be considered as new. Memberships received after September 1st will be valid through the next calendar year.
