### Minutes from the September 17, 2014 ACCC E-Board Meeting

Daryl and Cindy Burbach attended the board meeting.

Cindy presented an idea for a club activity. She suggested the club hold a swap meet and invite other clubs to participate. We discussed several options for locations and times, and if there would be enough support from the membership. David asked her to check into some locations and let us know.

Daryl reported on the status of the nomination committee for the upcoming club officer election. We will need to elect four new board members in November and need nominees. The board suggested several names for the committee to approach.

Travis Pearson presented the board with information for club insurance coverage from Haggerty Insurance. He reported the coverage was very similar to what we get through the NCCC. The board asked him to submit an application in order to get a quote for the coverage. We also asked him to check with American National insurance.

Kent reported that if the club could save enough on insurance coverage we could revise our dues structure. However that will require a constitutional amendment and we would need to get the insurance by the end of November as that is when the NCCC dues are due. So we need to get the quotes and publish a notice so we can put the issue to a vote at the next meeting.

Gary Jones reported we have \$61.75 in Cash, and \$1654.80 in checking.

The next regular meeting will be October the 8th and the next board meeting will be October 22nd.

If you already have an NCCC membership elsewhere, **Regular Membership** dues for ACCC are \$25.00 per year for new members and \$20.00 per year for renewals. Please specify the following:

**Associate membership**, designed for the non-Corvette owner, is \$25.00 per year for new members and \$20.00 per year for renewals. Dues for renewals are payable on September 1st and are considered delinquent after the November ACCC meeting. Renewals received after the November meeting will be considered as new. Memberships received after September 1st will be valid through the next calendar year.


