Our club sponsored Best Western All Corvette Car Show is next Saturday. This is a "show and shine" and there's no entry fee.

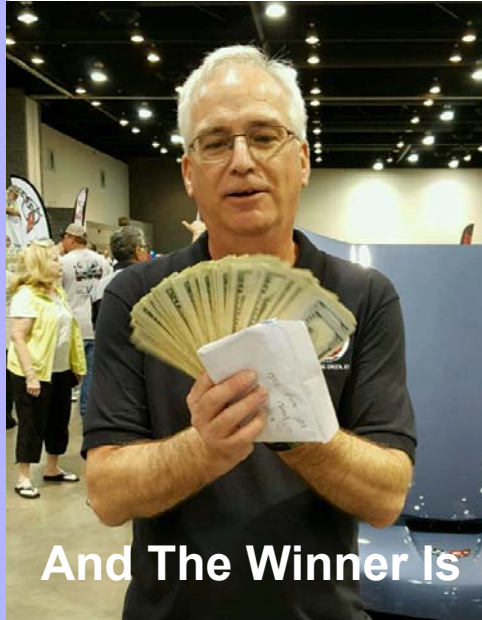

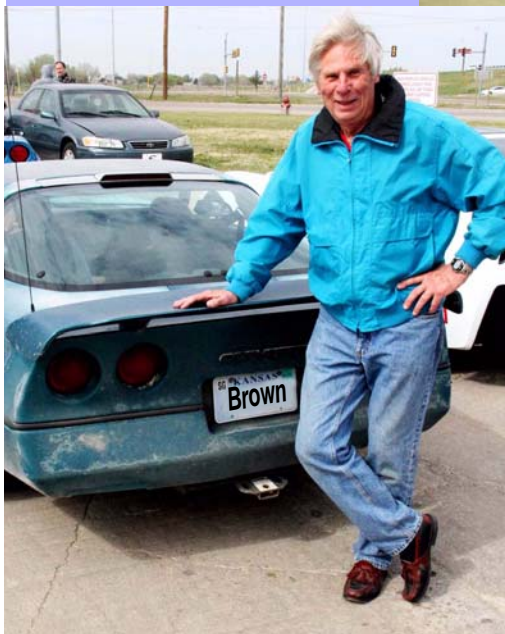
