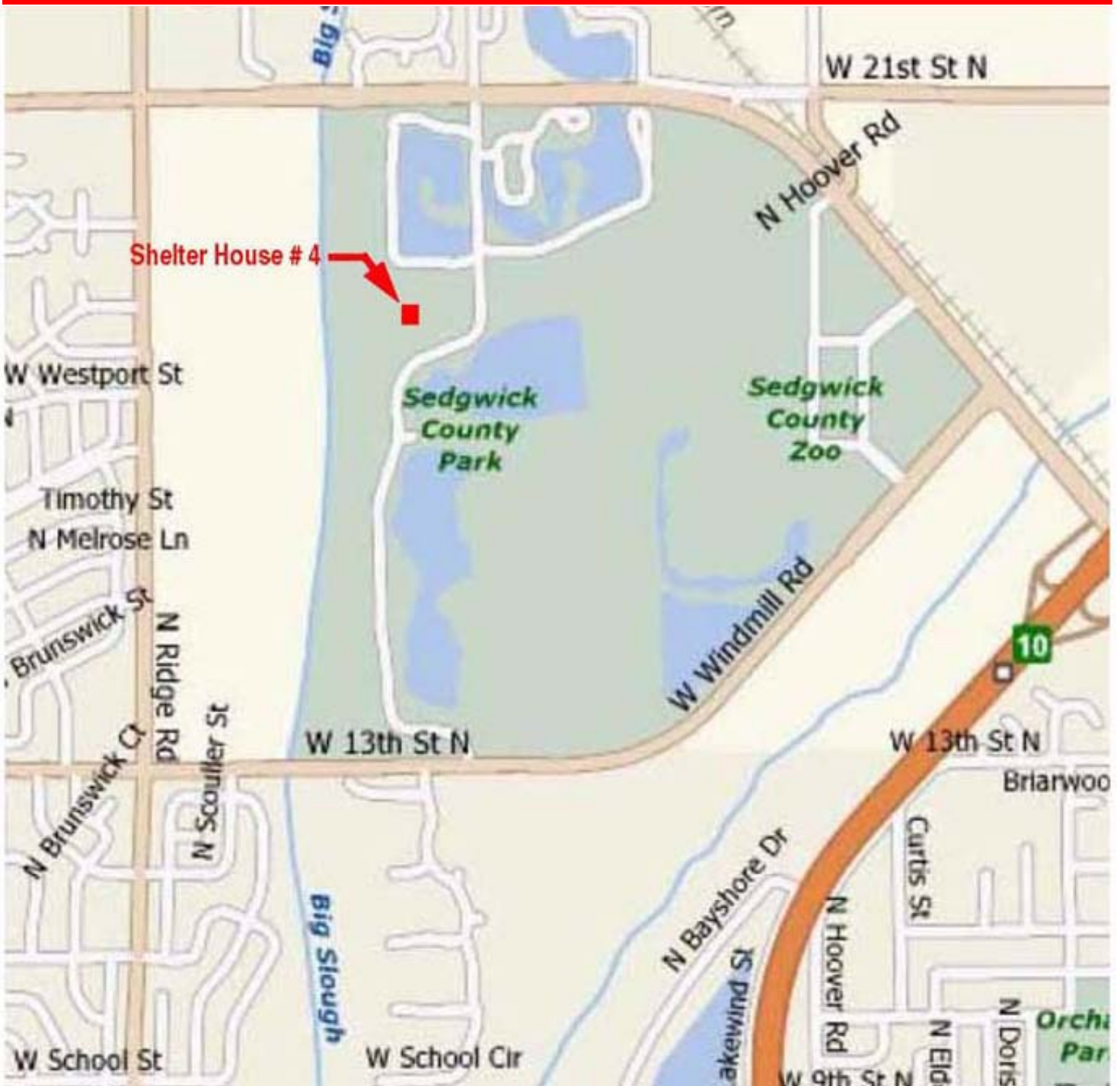
The turnout was a little down from past years at the Lake Afton Car show. It was very hot, but still enjoyable to see all the different cars.
