Brad gave a summary of upcoming events. It was noted the Eureka Springs autocross even has been cancelled for this year.

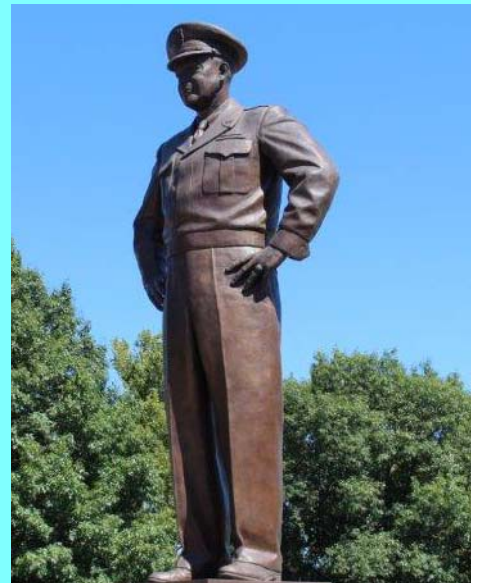
Eboard candidates will be announced at the October general meeting. Copies of the revised club constitution and new bylaws will be available at this meeting also.
