WACCC Meeting Minutes, Tuesday, August 20, 2013 Linwood Park Recreation Center

Meeting was called to order at 7:05PM by President Margaret Brinkley.

There were 16 people in attendance including club representatives, officers, and guests.

Mike McNeil gave the treasurer's report with a balance of \$2788.79. All bills are paid including newsletter postage and the vests that were purchased for Lake Afton. The referenced balance includes the \$400 from the Mustang Club for the Lake Afton 2014 Featured Club. Check was presented by Richard Mann. Motion made by Chris Pile to accept the treasurer's report as presented. Seconded by Kent Michael, motion passed.

It was brought to the attention of the Council there was one (1) correction to the May 21, 2013 minutes. It was stated that the featured Mustang Club for Lake Afton 2014 would be celebrating the Mustang's 60th Anniversary. Correction - it will be the 50th Anniversary of the Mustang. Minutes are amended.

After the correction, motion was made by Chris Pile and seconded by Jacob Parker to accept the minutes of the May 21, 2013 meeting as printed in the newsletter. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

Margaret read a letter from KJ's Rainbow Snow. They were one of the vendors from the Lake Afton Show. They extended a huge thank you and kudos for a great car show. It was their first year to participate and look forward to returning next year. They thought it was a great event and wanted to thank the Council for inviting them to participate. This was the first time the Council has ever received a thank you letter from a show vendor. All other vendors did express their desire to return to next year's show too.

There was some discussion as to whether we should invite more food vendors next year. Was decided that four (4) was an adequate number to serve the show and allow each vendor to do well.

One vendor did hit and tip the lid off the sewer cap. Margaret talked to Mark at Lake Afton and called the vendor. The vendor said he did knock the cap off but did not think he did any damage to the sewer. This sewer drainage pipe is quite a ways under ground and thought it would be most difficult to hurt that part of the drain. As of this date we have not heard anything further on this issue nor have we been contacted by Mark. We will table this incident unless something should arise in the future.

Only other incident or issue with this year's show was the golf cart situation and in particular with our DJ. As in years past, we have asked participants not to use golf carts at the show unless they are disabled. The flyer clearly states our position on carts at the Lake Afton show. The DJ was asked not to use his golf cart. After an intense discussion of the situation, he left the premises and was extremely upset. The Council feels they must take this position for the well being and safety of all involved including the liability of WACCC. Because not everyone sees the flyer, it was discussed that perhaps we should put up signs day of the event to remind everyone of the golf cart policy. Mike mentioned that this DJ had donated his time for several years and it was an unfortunate incident. We need to ensure that this topic is well mentioned on the 2014 flyer in order to avoid any further situations.

All shirts were sold and only about 12 dash plaques were left. One was given to each vendor and the remainder sold.

It was mentioned that Rusty Eck might be able to assist with the design. Mustang Club will discuss and advise.

Margaret reminded everyone that the election of officers for 2014 will be at the November meeting. It was noted that the current officers would be willing to remain in office for the coming year.
